Meeting minutes from the North Davis Fire District Board of Trustee Meeting, held at approximately 6:00 PM on August 15, 2019 at Station 41, 381 North 3150 West, West Point City, Utah 84015.

**Board Members Present**: Vice-Chairman Mark Shepherd, Scott Wiggill, Jerry Chatterton, Nancy Smalling, Tim Roper and Nike Peterson (arrived at approximately 6:15 pm)

Board Members Excused: Gary Petersen, Howard Madsen and Erik Craythorne

Staff Present: Fire Chief Mark Becraft, Deputy Fire Chief John Taylor, District Clerk Misty Rogers

Visitors: Firefighters' Dan Holman and Daren Coleman

- 1. Call to Order: Vice-Chairman Shepherd called the Board of Trustees Meeting to order
- 2. Invocation or Inspirational Thoughts: Provided by Board Member Roper
- 3. Pledge of Allegiance
- 4. Citizen Comment: None
- 5. Consideration of Approval of Minutes from the June 20, 2019 Board Meeting Board Member Chatterton motioned to approve the minutes from the June 20, 2019 Board of Trustees Meeting Board Member Wiggill seconded the motion

Board Member Wiggill seconded the motion The motion passed unanimously

 Consideration of Approval of the North Davis Fire District Bills for June 2019 and July 2019 Ms. Rogers stated that Fiscal Year 2019 ended on June 30, 2019 and Fiscal Year 2020 began on July 1,

2019. She then stated that because of timing, adjustments to revenues and expenditures for both fiscal years must be made before the annual audit process begins.

Board Member Roper motioned to approve the bills for June 2019 and July 2019 Board Member Chatterton seconded the motion The motion passed unanimously

## 7. Consideration of Approval of the North Davis Fire District Financial Report

Chief Becraft stated that two financial reports were included in the packet. The first report is for Fiscal Year 2019 and the second report is for Fiscal Year 2020. He then stated that adjustments to both revenues and expenditures will be made in both fiscal years and that money will likely be returned to the General Fund in Fiscal Year 2019. He then informed the board that he and Ms. Rogers recently met with a representative from Zions Bank to discuss bonding. The meeting with Zions Bank went well and

interest rates for bonding are extremely low. However, refinancing the current debt service bond would not save the District enough money to justify refinancing.

Board Member Chatterton motioned to approve the North Davis Fire District Financial Report Board Member Roper seconded the motion The motion passed unanimously

## 8. Fire Chiefs Report

Chief Becraft informed the Board of Trustees of the following:

• Fuelman Gas Card fraud - At the discretion of Chief Becraft, all gas cards associated with Fuelman fuel system had been shut-down due to continuous unauthorized charges. Administration has audited all charges listed on the Fuelman bill and the District has only paid Fuelman for authorized charges. The District will work with the State of Utah and Fuelman to determine who is responsible to pay for the unauthorized charges.

Board Member Wiggill asked if the North Davis Fire District could be at risk by not paying for the unauthorized charges. Chief Becraft stated that administration will keep in contact with the State of Utah and Fuelman to ensure that the District remains in good standing.

- Fire Rescue International (FRI) Administration recently returned from FRI which was held in Atlanta, Georgia. Chief Becraft then stated that the FRI conference was exceptional and the education provided by attending classes and networking will benefit the District. He then stated that while attending a Fire Chiefs meeting, the possibility of Utah participating the Western Fire Rules and Regulations Committee was discussed.
- Mental Health Awareness Chief Becraft stated that the mental health is extremely important with
  police and fire. The District is always looking for ways to assist our employees with mental health.
  Chief Becraft stated that the District must continue to be proactive with mental health awareness.
  He then stated that he and Deputy Chief Taylor are working towards creating and implementing
  standard operating procedures with the mental health and wellness of firefighters in mind.
- Zoll Defibrillators The Zoll Defibrillators which were included in the Fiscal Year 2020 Budget will be delivered next week and training on the new devices will begin immediately. All employees will be required to train on the device. The new defibrillators will allow for Bluetooth and WIFI connectivity.
- Paramedic RFP Committee Chief Becraft has been and will continue to meet with the Paramedic RFP Committee. Within the next few weeks, the committee will meet with police, fire, dispatch and anyone who could be involved in the process. Chief Becraft stated that recent Paramedic RFP Committee meetings have been productive and those involved have been open to discussion and seem willing to work together to find a solution.
- Layton Apartment Complex Fire The North Davis Fire District recently assisted a fire at an apartment complex in Layton. Chief Becraft stated that NDFD Firefighters performed exceptionally well and that fire ground discipline is extremely important. He then stated that NDFD Firefighters worked well with the surrounding agencies and their hard work and discipline was noticed by other Fire Chiefs.

• Wildfires – So far, the wildfire season has been quiet and there have not been many firework related incidents.

Board Member Wiggill expressed the importance and need for the mental health assistance for the firefighters and employees of the District.

Chief Taylor stated that District will be hosting a mental health awareness class for each firefighter and their significant other. He then expressed the importance of keeping NDFD firefighters physically and mentally healthy.

## INTERLOCAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT FOR PARAMEDIC ABOARD CHARGES BETWEEN ROY CITY CORPORATION AND NORTH DAVIS FIRE DISTRICT

This Agreement made and entered into the \_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_, 2019 ("Effective Date") pursuant to the provisions of the Interlocal Cooperation Act, Section 11-13-101, et. seq., Utah Code Annotated, 1953 as amended, by and between Roy City Corporation and North Davis Fire District.

## WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, Roy City, provides paramedic services in this role hereinafter referred to as "Paramedic Providers"; and

WHEREAS, North Davis Fire District is an ambulance transport service within Davis County, in this role hereinafter referred to as "Ambulance Transport Providers;" and

WHEREAS, some health insurance providers will only accept and pay claims for paramedic aboard fees billed directly by the ambulance provider and will not accept a separate and independent billing for the paramedic aboard fee from a Paramedic Provider; and

WHEREAS, the parties are desirous of providing for the reimbursement to the Paramedic Providers by the Ambulance Transport Providers for paramedic services rendered during ambulance transport in those instances where the Paramedic Provider is not able to bill independently for such services.

NOW, THEREFORE, upon the mutual promises and other good and satisfactory consideration, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. All charges shall be in accordance with the rate schedule adopted by the State Emergency Medical Services Committee in accordance with Section R426-8-2(3)(d)(iv) Utah Administrative Code, as amended from time to time.
- 2. As outlined in Section 4, an Ambulance Transport Provider shall pay a Paramedic Provider for each "PMA Call" assisted by the Paramedic Provider, upon a request by the Paramedic Provider (hereinafter referred to as a "Request for Collection"). The Ambulance Transport Provider shall collect the allowable charges for such paramedic services provided in conjunction with their own permitted charges. "PMA Call" means a paramedic aboard assisted call wherein paramedic(s) of the applicable Paramedic Provider accompany a patient to the hospital on an ambulance transport, operated by the applicable Ambulance Transport Provider from the place of assistance.
- 3. The applicable Ambulance Transport Provider shall pay the applicable Paramedic Provider on a monthly basis for all PMA calls assisted by that Paramedic Provider for which a Request for Collection has been made. Payments shall be for all such PMA calls rendered after midnight of the first day of the month to midnight of the last day of the month. The Ambulance Transport Provider shall resolve or dispute any

incidents deemed erroneous as provided by the Paramedic Provider, within thirty (30) days of when invoice is received. Such disputes or adjustments shall be conveyed to the Paramedic Provider for prompt resolution. Payment to the applicable Paramedic Provider shall be made by the applicable Ambulance Transport Provider within ninety (90) days for which payment is due. If payment is not received within ninety (90) days for which payment is due, the Ambulance Transport Provider *may* incur interest of 1.5% per month past payment due date. The Paramedic Provider shall provide a monthly report to each Ambulance Transport Provider detailing all PMA calls of that Ambulance Transport Provider assisted by that Paramedic Provider for which a Request for Collection has been made, based on actual run reports.

## 4. Paramedic Fee and Allowable Adjustments.

Pursuant to Section R426-8-2(3)(d)(iv) Utah Administrative Code, as amended from time to time, all Ambulance Transport Providers within this agreement agree to make good faith efforts to collect the paramedic aboard fee. Regardless of the collection amount received by the Ambulance Transport Providers, they agree to make payment to the Paramedic Providers for the amount calculated by the formula outline below. The Paramedic Providers agree to accept the calculated amount as full payment for each billed PMA Call.

The formula consists of the Ambulance Transport Provider's gross annual collection rate percentage multiplied by the State approved PMA rate of \$486.00. This amount will be adjusted annually on July 1<sup>st</sup> as the State approved PMA rate changes, and as the reported collection rate of each Ambulance Transport Provider changes (see Section 13).

- 5. <u>Term</u>. The term of this Agreement will begin on the effective date and shall continue to be in force for a period of five (5) years, unless terminated as provided herein. Any party may terminate its obligations hereunder by giving thirty (30) days advance written notice to the other parties. Such termination shall not modify the Agreement as between any of the remaining parties, except only to exclude the terminating party from the obligations created herein. Should this agreement be terminated by any party, the Ambulance Transport Provider acknowledges and agrees to stop billing the ALS rate when transporting with that Paramedic Provider. The Paramedic Provider also acknowledges and agrees to be responsible for collecting the paramedic aboard fee when transporting with that Ambulance Transport Provider.
- 6. <u>Administrative Entity</u>. It is the intent and understanding of all parties that no new entity is created by this Agreement. This Agreement shall be administered by the parties and each party shall appoint a representative to facilitate performance of this Agreement.
- 7. <u>Independent Contractors</u>. In the performance of this Agreement, the parties are independent contractors, and as such shall have no authorization, expressed or implied, to bind any other party to any agreements, settlements, liability, or understanding whatsoever, and agree not to perform any such acts as agent for any other party except as expressly set forth herein.

- 8. <u>Hold Harmless</u>. Each party shall indemnify, defend, and hold the other parties, their officers, agents, and employees harmless from any and all claims, demands, liabilities, costs, expenses, penalties, damages, losses, and liens, including, without limitation, reasonable attorney's fees, arising out of or any way related to any act, omission or event occurring as a consequence of performing under this Agreement; provided, however, that each party shall be responsible for its own negligent acts and agrees to indemnify and hold the other parties harmless therefrom.
- 9. <u>Governmental Immunity</u>. All parties to this agreement are governmental entities as defined in the Utah Governmental Immunity Act found in Title 63G Chapter 7 of the Utah Code. Nothing in this agreement shall be construed as a waiver by any party of any rights, limits, protections or defenses provided by the Act. Nor shall this agreement be construed, with respect to third parties, as a waiver of any governmental immunity to which a party to this agreement is otherwise entitled. Subject to the Act, each party will be responsible for its own actions and will defend any lawsuit brought against it and pay any damages awarded against it.
- 10. <u>Manner of Financing</u>. This Agreement and the matters contemplated herein shall not receive separate financing, nor shall a separate budget be required. Each party shall be responsible for its own obligations under this Agreement, and shall be responsible for any costs incurred as a result thereof.
- 11. <u>Filing of Agreement</u>. A copy of this Agreement shall be placed on file in the Office of the Recorder of any participating Agency or maintained with the parties' other official records, and shall remain on file for public inspection during the term of this Agreement.
- 12. <u>Governing Law, Jurisdiction and Venue</u>. This Agreement is made and entered into subject to the provisions of the laws of the State of Utah, which laws shall control the enforcement of this Agreement. The parties also recognize that certain Federal laws may be applicable. In the event of any conflict between this Agreement and the applicable State or Federal law, the State or Federal law shall control.
- 13. <u>Review and Rate Reporting</u>. The parties, through their appointed representatives, shall meet annually to review this Agreement, the collection rate of each individual Ambulance Transport Provider, and to discuss any matters or issues that may arise under this Agreement. "Gross Collection Rate" is referred to as the providers' <u>Gross Receipts divided by Gross Charges</u>. This will be the rate used to calculate PMA charges for that Ambulance Transport Provider starting in July of the current year. The collection rate reported by each Ambulance Transport Provider shall be their Gross Collection Rate from the previous <u>calendar year</u>.
- 14. <u>Compliance with Laws</u>. In connection with their activities under this Agreement, the parties shall comply with all applicable federal, state and local laws and regulations.
- 15. <u>Property</u>. No real or personal property shall be acquired, nor improvements constructed by the parties as a result of this Agreement.

## 16. General Provisions.

- A. <u>Severability</u>. In the event that any condition, covenant, or other provision herein contained is held to be invalid or void by any court of competent jurisdiction, the same shall be deemed severable from the remainder of this Agreement and shall in no way affect any other covenant or condition herein contained. If such condition, covenant, or other provision shall be deemed invalid due to its scope or breadth, such provision shall be deemed valid to the extent of the scope or breadth permitted by law.
- B. <u>Entire Agreement</u>. This Agreement contains the entire agreement between the parties. No promise, representation, warranty, or covenant not included in this Agreement has been or is relied upon by the parties. All prior understandings, negotiations, or agreements are merged herein and superseded hereby.
- C. <u>Amendments</u>. This Agreement may be modified only by a written amendment signed by each of the parties hereto.
- D. <u>Not Assignable</u>. This Agreement is specific to the parties hereto and is therefore not assignable.
- E. <u>Counterparts</u>. This Agreement may be executed in two or more counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original, but all of which shall constitute one and the same instrument.
- F. <u>No Partnership, Joint Venture, or Third Party Rights.</u> Nothing in this Agreement shall be construed as creating any partnership, joint venture, or business arrangement among the parties hereto, nor any rights or benefits to third parties.
- 17. <u>Resolution by Governing Bodies</u>. This Interlocal Agreement shall become effective immediately upon (1) the execution of, or an appropriate resolution approving, this Agreement by the applicable commission, board, council or body or officer of each entity vested with executive power of the entity; (2) approval as to form by the authorized attorney for each entity; and, (3) the filing of the executed Agreement with the keeper of records for each participating entity. Upon becoming effective, this Agreement negates, nullifies, supplants and/or replaces any previous Inter-local Agreement.

**WHEREAS**, the North Davis Fire District desires to enter into this agreement pursuant to the provisions of and authority granted to them by the Utah Interlocal Cooperation Act, as set forth in Title Utah Code Annotated 11-13-101, et seq., and Utah Code Annotated 11-7-1, et seq., 1953, as amended, which is attached as Exhibit "A".

#### Mutual Aid Fire Protection Agreement between Roy City and North Davis Fire District

AGREEMENT made this \_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_, 2019, by and among Roy City, and North Davis Fire District.

WHEREAS, the parties are desirous of entering into a mutual agreement for fire protection, fire related emergencies and medical emergencies that will be beneficial to all parties; and

WHEREAS, the undersigned are entering this Agreement pursuant to Utah Code Annotated 11-13-101, et seq., and Utah Code Annotated 11-7-1, et seq., 1953, as amended, to provide a joint mutual agreement relating to the mutual response and use of firefighting equipment and personnel to fight structure fires and fire-service-related emergencies which include first response medical and basic ambulance transportation; however, excludes emergencies which require the use of hazardous material equipment or personnel both within and outside the normal geographical jurisdictional limits of each party hereto, unless the requesting department's governing body has enacted a cost recovery ordinance; and

WHEREAS, each party desires to cooperate with and assist the others in times of emergency or disaster.

#### NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY AGREED:

1. The area to be served by this Agreement shall be within Roy City and North Davis response district.

2. The Fire Department of each party agrees to respond to structure fires and fire/medical-servicerelated emergencies within the geographical area of a requesting party to this Agreement with equipment and manpower based upon need as determined by the requesting party's incident Commander and as equipment and personnel are available as determined by the senior officer on duty for the responding party.

3. The dispatcher shall dispatch the Fire Department from the jurisdiction where the incident is located first, and then, upon determination of need by the incident commander, a request for assistance may be made.

4. Only upon determination by the requesting department that an incident is of such a nature that additional resources are needed, and then only upon the request of the incident commander of the jurisdiction where the incident occurs, will departments be dispatched to respond as provided herein. Self-dispatching of resources by participating Fire Departments of this agreement without the official request of the incident commander of the incident commander of the responsible jurisdiction is not acceptable.

5. Response under this Agreement shall be made only when the absence of fire personnel and/or equipment will not jeopardize the fire protection of the governmental entity furnishing assistance to the another jurisdiction.

6. The dispatcher shall be requested to specify the location and directions, when necessary, to which the fire department equipment and personnel are to be dispatched; however, the amount and type of equipment and number of personnel to be furnished shall be finally determined by the responding organization.

7. The responding organization shall report to the incident commander in charge at the location to which the fire equipment and personnel are dispatched and shall be subject to the orders of that officer. This

incident commander in charge shall be a member of the governmental entity's fire department on scene at location where the incident is located, e.g., if the incident is within North Davis Fire District the incident commander on scene shall be in charge.

8. Responding equipment and personnel shall be released by the officer in charge when the services of the responding organization are no longer required, or when the responding organization is needed within the area for which it normally provides fire protection.

9. Each party shall indemnify, defend, and hold all other parties, their officers, agents, and employees harmless from any and all claims, demands, liabilities, costs, expenses, penalties, damages, losses and liens, including without limitation, reasonable attorney's fees, arising out of or in any way related to any act, omission or event occurring as a consequence of performing under this Agreement; provided, however, that each party shall be responsible for its own negligent acts and agrees to indemnify and hold the other party harmless there from. In no event shall this section be construed with respect to third parties as a waiver of any governmental immunity to which the parties are otherwise entitled.

10. Parties to this Agreement shall participate in their respected County's Fire Officers Association forums and shall adopt safety procedures as may be developed in such forums, in the interest of firefighter safety.

11. The effect of the death or injury of any firefighter who is killed or injured outside the territorial limits of the governmental entity where he is a member of the firefighting department and while that department is functioning pursuant to this Agreement shall be the same as if he were killed or injured while that department was functioning within its own territorial limits; and such death or injury shall be considered to be in the line of duty.

12. Each party to this Agreement shall be responsible for worker's compensation and other benefits accruing to the members of their own department and such other employee-related matters, including insurance, as would normally occur for their own department.

13. No party to this Agreement shall be reimbursed by any other party to this Agreement for any direct expenses or direct losses incurred as a result of providing fire department services within another party's jurisdiction under the terms of this Agreement, except as otherwise provided and funded through cost recovery ordinances, or funding made available to the requesting Fire Department through state or federal resources. However, a party to this Agreement, at its option, may file a claim with the United States for the amount of its direct expenses and direct losses, incurred by fire department services rendered as a result of fighting a fire or fires on property of the United States, under authority of 15 USC 2210.

14. There is no separate legal entity created by this Agreement to carry out its provisions; and to the extent that this Agreement requires administration other than as is set forth herein, it shall be administered by the governing bodies of the parties acting as a joint board. There shall be no real or personal property acquired jointly by the parties as a result of this Agreement.

15. This Agreement shall not relieve any party to this Agreement of any obligation or responsibility imposed upon a party to this Agreement by law, except that the performance of a responding party may be offered in satisfaction of any such obligation or responsibility of the requesting party to the extent of actual and timely performance thereof by the responding party.

16. The term of this Agreement shall commence on the date of execution by the last party hereto and shall continue for a period of five (5) Years. Any party may terminate its obligations hereunder without cause by providing thirty (30) days prior written notice.

17. This Agreement, as a condition precedent to its entry into effect, shall be submitted to the authorized attorney of each governmental entity for approval as to form in accordance with the provision of Section 11-13-202.5(3), Utah Code Annotated, 1953, as amended.

18. The individuals signing this Agreement on behalf of each of the parties confirm that they are the duly authorized representatives of the parties and are lawfully enabled to sign this Agreement on behalf of the parties.
